Sl. No.	The school is directed to ensure that:
1	The total number of section of the school shall be restricted to 38. The total number of sections taken together for classes XI and XII should not be more than 1/3 of the number of section allowed. Further increase of section shall be subject to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation bye laws and subject to the availability of room size of greater than 500 sq ft.
2	As per undertaking uploaded by the school on mandatory public disclosure that the school will accommodate students upto class XII in 38 sections as admissible as per Appendix-V. Hence, the school is directed not to exceed the number of sections until the school is acquired more land.
3	The land area mentioned in the land certificate is 6580 sq mt whereas in the OASIS data filled by the school it is mentioned that the total land area 27307 sq mt and playground 11000 sq mt. Hence the school is directed to apply on SARAS portal for correction of land area in OASIS.
4	The CWSN toilets are not as per norms, the rods fixed in the wall is too high to hold and in wrong direction which will be difficult to use by a person with disability. Moreover, the CWSN toilets are not seen in all the floors. Hence the school must ensure the CWSN toilets in all the floors as per circular No. 5/2023 and submit the compliance within 3 months on SARAS portal.

5	There is no safety procedures in composite lab, no ventilators, no exhaust fans, the chemicals and gas connection are of easy access of the children and no fire extinguisher seen in the lab. The school shall upgrade the composite lab as per SoP issued by the Board within 3months and submit compliance on SARAS.
6	There is no hand railing alongside the ramp at the entrance. Hence the school is directed to fixed the hand railing and submit the compliance within 3 months on SARAS portal.
7	The school shall conduct training of its teachers with CoE Bhopal within 3 months and submit the compliance.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal.
